Dealer shows including Henlys of London and Jaguar-selling former TT rider Austin Munks of Boston, Lincs, before being sold to Coombs of Guildford (May 1957) as 'shop-soiled' car. Purchased that October by G. Sportoletti Baduel of London, and used by him as a road car, with regular servicing at Henlys. Converted to 'touring specification' similar to XKSS, including fitting of passenger door and removal of decking between seats; unique features were the windscreen (probably the rear screen of a saloon car) and the adaption of a second headrest/faring for the passenger. Regular Continental tours and two major works services (1959 and 1961). Offered for sale by the late Paul Hawkins in 1966 as 'built for Mille Miglia' (though the race was defunct). Later owners: Colin Crabbe, David Hoskison and Peter Agg of Trojan collection in Surrey. Sold via Coys of London in 1984, registered 77 EWW.
